



Mark Larscheidt Memorial Scholarship Program Rules

ELIGIBILITY:

- A. Applicants planning to or currently majoring in any profession, college or other training equivalent to at least: (1) four school years in length or (2) two school years in length.
- B. (1) All high school seniors or (2) high school graduates or older students currently enrolled in a post high school program including associate degree, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, MS, PhD, DVM program, etc. This scholarship program is open to **ALL** members.
- C. Applicants must have been Region 10 residents within the previous five years and be current members of a Region 10 affiliated club, such as Minnesota Arabian Horse Assn. or Wisconsin Arabian Horse Assn., and have been members for at least two (2) of the last five (5) years. **A copy of your membership card is required.**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- A. Three letters of recommendation:
 - One from a horseperson, with comments on applicant's equine abilities and experiences,
 - One from a teacher or advisor indicating the quality of work in school OR one from an employer or supervisor indicating the quality of performance at work,
 - One from any source (e. g. employer, clergyman, etc.).
- B. Proof of acceptance from the school where the scholarship will be applied.
(Required only after selection of recipient.)

COMMENTS:

- A. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be mailed to:

and **POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE MAY 15, 2020**. Applications and letters postmarked after that date **WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE**.
- B. Documents should be submitted in a large flat envelope, not folded and not stapled together.
- C. Documents should only be printed on one side.
- D. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than the Fall of 2020.
- E. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school or the school and the recipient upon enrollment for the fall semester. Recipients must inform us how the school wants the check made out.
- F. Recipients are only eligible for ONE award.
